Cleaning and Storing Filter Cartridges

- ◆ Once you are finished filtering, run fresh, clean water through your filtering system to rinse the wine out of the filter housing, filter cartridge and hoses. <u>Do not back flush the filter cartridges</u>.
- Remove the O-rings on the filter cartridge and place cartridge in storage tube. Store the O-rings in a safe, dry place. (We do not have extra O-rings so don't lose them.)
- You can store the rinsed filter cartridges in either a minimum 40% alcohol solution (for example, Vodka), or you can mix a storage solution. In a gallon of water add 2 teaspoons of Potassium Metabisulfite and 1 tablespoon of Citric Acid. Mix well. (Do not use Denatured Alcohol)
- ◆ Place the filter cartridges in the storage tube and fill the tube with the storage solution of your choice, fully immersing the cartridges.
- ♦ We have storage tubes for both the 10" and 20" filter cartridges.
